LAKE ST. CLAIR – DETROIT RIVER BOUNDARY

Under the authority of sections 41101 through 41105 of Act 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, as amended, being sections 324.41101 through 324.41105 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, the Director of the Department of Natural Resources on October 9, 2008 ordered that for a period of five years for the purposes of establishing statewide coolwater sport fishing regulations upon the waters of Lake St. Clair and the Detroit River, the boundary line between Lake St. Clair and the Detroit River shall be a line extending due south of the Windmill Point Light, Wayne County.

This order is assigned number FO-242.09 and is titled “Lake St. Clair – Detroit River Boundary.”

This order supersedes the order entitled “Lake St. Clair – Detroit River Boundary” effective April 1, 2004, and assigned number FO-242.04.

This order shall take effect on April 1, 2009, and shall remain effective through March 31, 2014.
